INTRODUCTION

Founder of our Maratha Vidhya Prasarak Samaj Nashik established Smt. Vimlaben Khimji Tejookaya Arts, Science & Commerce College, at Deolali Camp, Nashikon June 1984 to open the doors of higher education for the youth from rural and army background as well as from industrial town. This College is affiliated to Savitribai Phule University, Pune. The mission is to educate the youth & make them reliable to take active participation in development of India. Our college is accredited by NAAC in January 2012 & was awarded `A` grade with CGPA 3.10.

The Gender Audit is an attempt to study good gender balance. Similarly, to study whether college follows all the University rules, policies & action because it forms a constituent part of the University. This Gender Audit tries to check the impact of its current & proposed policies on Gender equality.

The college always concentrates on the overall personality development of all students. Observing the Gender equality, the girls are provided various facilities and special attention. As per the direction from D.G. NCC, 33% of new admission seats are reserved for girls' cadets, therefore, girl cadets are enrolled form 2017-18. However, girl NCC unit is available in our nearest sister branch KTHM College Nashik. The NSS unit has 300 intake capacities out of which about 70 % are girls. The unit always motivates the students for their social responsibilities and their empowerment. For safety, separate entrance, stair case, two-wheeler parking, cycle stand and study room are provided to girls. To make the girls aware of their rights and to impart knowledge of bylaws, counseling through lectures by legal advisers is arranged. These lectures are arranged every year by Sexual Harassment [Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal at Workplace] committee & Anti-Ragging Committee. In the department of cultural activities &sports, girls achieved grand success. Their active participation in Youth Festival and various competitions shows their ability and achievements.

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Objectives of Gender Audit:

Gender Audit of Smt.Vimlaben Khimji Tejookaya Arts, Commerce & Science College Deolali Camp, Nashik has the following objectives:

- To find out the gender balance existence in different areas and factors behind gender balance.
- To examine the policies of the college rules/actions towards needs and interest of both male and female.
- Take active steps to establish good gender balance in decision making processes in all areas of the college activities.
- 4. To suggest solutions to reduce gender inequality.
- 5. To promote growth of gender equality in all aspects.
- To look after the work and capacity for prevention and prohibition of sexual harassment at workplace.

Gender sensitive Features in S.V.K.T. College Deolali Camp, Nashik

Gender sensitive features are carefully observed in every corner of the college system. By forming various committees like Anti-ragging, Internal Complaints, and Sexual Harassment Prevention, and providing adequate facilities to both girls and boys, gender equality is always kept upright in the college.

Facilities for Students:

A) Entrance:

For safety measures of girls and to avoid chaotic situation during college hours a separate entrance with security personal is made available.

B) Parking facility:

A well observed separate parking for two wheelers and bicycles for girls is one of the disciplines in our college.

C) Study Room :

A study room that caters well to the needs of all students as well as the staff.

D) Separate book issuing Window:

Separate book issuing window marks discipline and convenience.

E) Ladies Room and Wash Room:

Ladies Room provision is made for girls for resting. A notice board is also placed in Ladies Room. Wash Rooms are there with ample water supply and daily cleaning. Female faculty members take care of girls wherever necessary. Automatic sanitary napkin vending machine and an incinerator has been installed in the wash room of girls to ensure hygiene and health. A separate wash room is provided to women faculty members.

F) Drinking Water:

A separate clean drinking water facility is there for girls.

G) Canteen:

No Canteen is in the campus but canteen is made available outside college premises with separate girls compartment.

H) Health Camp:

Every year Health camps, Blood donation and hemoglobin checkup camps are arranged by NSS & NCC departments.

I) SMS Alert System:

An SMS Alert System for information dissemination about important dates and notices among the students and the staff is managed. J) Sports facilities:

College takes special efforts to promote sports among the students. Indoor games in the college kabaddi, hockey, netball, Korfball, Football, Handball, judo, wrestling, karate, taekwondo, etc. I) Gender Balance in Enrolment at Graduation and Post-graduation Level:

SVKT College is located in Cantonment and rural area. It is reputed for co-education and discipline. Students' strength is increasing continuously. Basically, girl student strength is more than boys.

Faculty Wise Gender Distribution in Enrolment at Graduation Level









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Category Wise Gender Distribution in Enrolment at Post-Graduation Level

IV) Health Check up Camp for Students:

Every year health check up camp is organised for students. It has been carried out in collaboration with MVP's Dr. Vasantrao Pawar Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Nashik. Almost all students have been checked for blood group, hemoglobin and blood pressure. A free check-up camp has been organised by our college and doctors of various specializations were invited for consultation. In the year 2019-20, 860 students were benefited by free-check up camp. Among them, 480 were boys and 380 were girls.

Beneficiaries of Free Health Check- up Camp

Total 480 boys and 380 girls are benefited by health check-up camp. More boys are benefited than girls from health checkup camp.

Every year Department of Microbiology organizes checkup. These girls with low Hemoglobin are advised for suitable diet for 1 week. Thereafter this is again checked. In academic Year 2019-20 70girl's hemoglobin has been checked. Medical assistance to students and staff.

A general insurance policy is available for students at very low premium Rs. 175/-. Every student is insured for accident and his or her family is insured for health for Rs. 1,00,000. The institute MVP has tie up with Heath India Insurance. This health insurance facility is also available for staff which covers their family.

V) Anti-Ragging and Prevention of Sexual Harassment

a) Anti- Ragging and Discipline Committee:

As the college forms a constituent part of the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, some of its responsibilities are shared and covered by jointly. The college has displayed all rules and regulations on flex board in the college campus. Ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has notified Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in highly educational institutions in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. The college forms Anti-Ragging and Discipline Committee.

Every year college forms Discipline Committee for maintaining Discipline in the campus. The college publishes its rules and regulations in prospectus. Ragging is a criminal offence. Government and UGC has notified regulation for higher education institutes in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the ragging. The college has antiragging committee, especially to look after the ragging issues. The committee has male and female members and the principal of the college is the chairperson of the committee. Every student has to fill the details in anti-ragging form during the time of admission. No issue has been reported in the college till date.



- ✓ Responses of students, faculty, staff members, parent and visitors are regularly sought in formal and informal ways and the same are audited for gender balance and issues raised in the areas are reported to the administration

RECOMMENDATIOS FOR MAKING S.V.K.T.COLLEGE AS A GENDER SENSITIVECOLLEGE:

- ✓ There is a need to increase number of female staff members in both teaching as well as non-teaching category.
- The Sexual Harassment of Women at Work Place [Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal] Committee should include one lady police officer.

- ✓ There is a need to conduct more programs for male student about gender sensitization
- ✓ The college may start special Wall Paper activity for girl students
- ✓ Students must be encouraged to write for local news papers about gender related issues
