Treatment depends on the drug being abused, whether addiction is present, and whether there are coexisting health or psychological problems. 





#### Report of Bacteriological Analysis of Water 2015-16

Bacteriological Analysis of drinking water for its portability is our departmental yearly activity conducted by staff and students.

In academic year 2015-16, our department tested 25 water samples brought by Students of T.Y.B.Sc from different sources like tap water,borewell water,well water and different water purifiers such as aqua guard, RO etc. The collected samples were tested by Most Probable Number test recommended by World Health Organization.

Among the samples collected it was found that 10 samples of tap water, 6 samples of well water, and 2 samples of borewell water samples were contaminated and the samples from RO and Aquagaard were found to be safe. About 72% of water samples were found to be non-pdtable.ie. It contains a greater number of fecal colliforms than the permissible limit laid down by the WHO. Presence of these organisms in the water is an indication of presence of other gastrointestinal tract disease causing pathogens.

Following recommendations were given:-

- 1. Maintenance of Cleanliness near water storing premises.
- 2. Cleanliness of utensils and handling process.
- 3. Maintain personal hygienic conditions.

The outcome of above activity was to apply knowledge gained at field level, development of awareness among students and villagers regarding clean and safe drinking water and water related health hazards.

Under this activity hemoglobin checkup of girls was carried out by the department at free of cost. Among all 35% girls were found to be anemic.

No of beneficiaries - 117

Outcome:-

Girl's students got aware of their hemoglobin and anemic conditions (below normal level). Students of T.Y.B.Sc got the hand on experience of the technique of hemoglobin and blood group testing. They also got the experience of use of knowledge at field level.

Recommendations:-

Diet suggestions were given so as to increase hemoglobin percentage.

S.V.K.T. College is located in semi rural area and majority of the students are from agriculture background. Most of the farmers are illiterate and don't have enough knowledge regarding soil testing. Soil analysis can help them for using correct fertilizer required for their soil.

The department of chemistry in association with Om laboratories, Senapati, Vadner gate, Nashik unanimously decided to work for such community, so that it will prove beneficial for the farming community. Under the scheme of the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Government of India, there is a provision for free soil analysis. Om Laboratory is the recognised laboratory in soil testing. From Academic year 2015-16, the department of chemistry collected soil samples from the farmers of nearby area and sent them to Om Laboratory for the analysis.

One day workshop on 'Kali Umaltana' under Student Welfare Board was organised on Wednesday 20-1-2016. While guiding the students, he said that girls have to face many physical and mental changes when they enter adolescence. If a girl keeps her diet right, she can lead a healthy life in the future and every person should undergo medical examination once a year.

Dr. Mangala Nikumbh coordinator of the programme given introduction of the programme. At that time, she said, in Vedic times, social and religious ceremonies were held to guide girls in their teens. The girls were being told how to behave, how to live. The same will be said today through this initiative. At this age they cannot be ignored. Communicate with them freely.

Dr. Mansi Kathale (Asso. Professor, Dept. of Obs.& Gynaecology, Dr.Vasantrao Pawar Medical College) giving guidance on this subject, said that the mood of girls in the age group of 13 to 19 starts changing. Many complaints start due to physical and mental changes, so girls should take a square diet and exercise regularly while taking care of their body. Get proper amount of protein, calcium and iron in your diet and stay away from diseases like obesity. The full development of girls is completed by the age of 18 years. Today, girls need to consume green leafy vegetables, milk, fruits and coarse wool. HPV VACCINE should be taken in three doses to prevent cervical cancer in women today.

Dr. Sandhya Gadakh (Principal,Law College) giving legal guidance said, "Study the society around you, know your duties, keep modern thinking but don't cross the line. Social is a feminine class, they don't know what law is. Second class." He is using the law as a weapon. Today, crime is on the rise in the society. Cyber crime is rampant. Girls should be vigilant like soldiers.

Mrs. Ashwini Boraste (Corporater,NMC,Nashik) giving guidance on financial empowerment said, "Set a goal in life. You can become financially capable through self help group. Learning is in the hands of man. But it requires continuous effort."Mrs. Sunita Adke gave guidance on youth and moral values.

The chairperson of the programme Principal of the college Dr. J. D. Sonkhaskar said that a very bad situation has arisen in the world today. While overcoming it, we have to keep our behaviour good in order to control the fickle human mind. Resist injustice; be disciplined because discipline builds confidence. 



- Students changed their attitude towards the counselling processes.






