
**Objectives:-** To create awareness regarding various form of energy, its utilization and save energy.

### **Math Enrichment Activities**

**Aim-** To promote new learning skills and techniques in mathematics at high school level to improve mathematical aptitude of primary and high school students.

**Objectives:**

- Introduce enrichment activities in mathematics to ensure students continue their education in mathematics uninterrupted.
- To encourage students to solve basic math problems using new approaches in problem solving.
- To mitigate the disruptive impact of the coronavirus pandemic on high school students' ability to learn and take interest in basic mathematics.
- To provide basic facilities including but not limited to textbooks, stationeries, etc. to students belonging to the rural households in Maharashtra.

#### **Mathematics Learning in the Era of COVID-19**

During the coronavirus pandemic, teachers have had to adapt the typical teaching techniques for classes that now take place online. The Pandemic has had an impact on education that is bringing up new policies and techniques for learning from home. In India, 320 million students have been affected by closure of schools due to COVID-19. The digital infrastructure to support online learning is still limited in rural regions of Maharashtra. Mathematics learning had to be adjusted to the 'new normal' to ensure sustainability in education. The Department of Mathematics at MVP' Samaj's SVKT College has taken definitive steps in keeping students engaged and involved in





skills in mathematics and introducing enrichment activities in mathematics learning for the students. The department has also reached beyond its obligations and engaged with high school students belonging to the rural households in Maharashtra, as they have been adversely affected by the closure of schools in their locality.

**Contributions made by MVP Samaj,s SVKT College:**

1. Mr. Mahendra Porje Director, of the Patriots Defense Academy, in collaboration with the Department of Mathematics, SVKT College introduced new learning techniques for the development of metacognitive abilities and problem solving skills of students. High school students were presented with simple problems in their settings and encouraged to come up with unique approaches to problems. Students were given open-ended problems to solve.
2. Mr. Mahendra Porje also encouraged students to recite mathematics tables and solve numerical problems in a unique and fun way. He prompted the students to talk about the math they're doing by asking open-ended questions and facilitated discussions, such as:
  - How many ways could you attempt to solve the problem?
  - Why did you choose to approach it in that way?
  - Why does that not work?
  - What happens if you try a different method? Can you arrive at the answer quicker by using this method?
3. Mr Mahendra Porje, and other teachers from SVKT College connected with students by every means possible. Arrangements were made for local classrooms to fit 10-20 students at a time and home teaching was also encouraged. Teachers were able to reach out to students via mobile phones and other available digital devices, eventually managing to connect with nearly 80% of our student body in high schools.
4. After making the contact, teachers then focused on finding out what the students and their families needed and constructed a tailor made curriculum to teach students. Students were shown what math looks like outside the classroom and what the real life applications of mathematics are.
5. Students were pushed to apply their knowledge in engaging and relevant ways and it gave them clues into where their math skills might take them. Seeing how math is actually applied in these authentic contexts helped students understand that math isn't just an abstract. It's a vital part of the world in which they live. Regular mathematical scavenger hunts were organized, with appropriate social distancing protocols, and students were encouraged to find the concepts they've

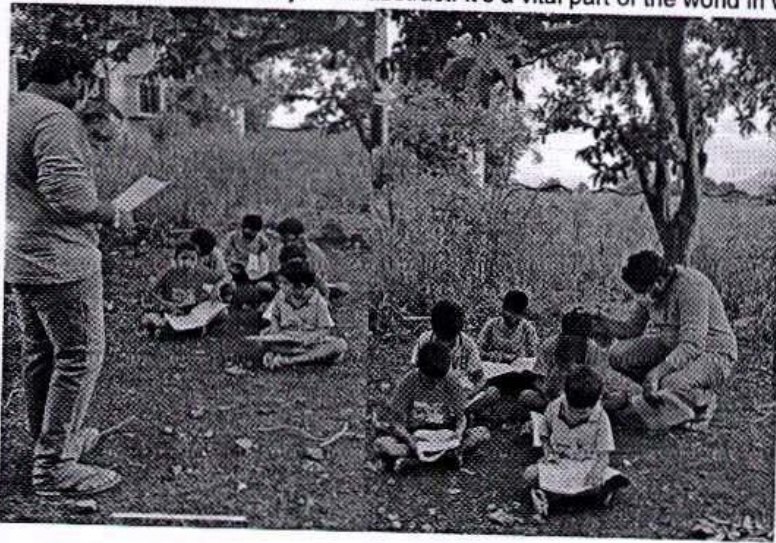




been learning in real, authentic contexts. For example, students were asked to find:

- Cartesian coordinate systems in patterns (in buildings, carpets, clothes)
- Calculate percentages in profit and loss at their local grocery stores
- Learn tables (newspapers, timetables)
- Solve fractions when ordering food in groups.

Seeing how math is actually applied in these authentic contexts helped students understand that math isn't just an abstract. It's a vital part of the world in which they live.

**Report of Bacteriological Analysis of Water Report 2019-20**

Bacteriological Analysis of drinking water for its potability is our departmental yearly activity conducted by staff. Every year approximately 100 water samples from different sources are tested.

In academic year 2019-20, our department tested 100 water samples brought by Student's which participated in NSS camp along with this water samples were also collected from village lavhit. The collected samples were tested with the help of **Most Probable Number** test recommended by **World Health Organization**. About 34% of water samples were found to be non-potable.

Following recommendations were given:-

1. Use of purifier.
2. Maintenance of Cleanliness near water storing premises.
3. Cleanliness of utensils and handling process.
4. Maintain personal hygienic conditions.

The outcome of above activity was development of awareness among students and villagers regarding clean and safe drinking water and water related health hazards.

Girl's students got aware of their hemoglobin and anemic conditions (below normal level). Students of T.Y.B.Sc got the hand on experience of the technique of hemoglobin and blood group testing. They also got the experience of use of knowledge at field level.

**Recommendations:-**

Diet suggestions were given so as to increase hemoglobin percentage.

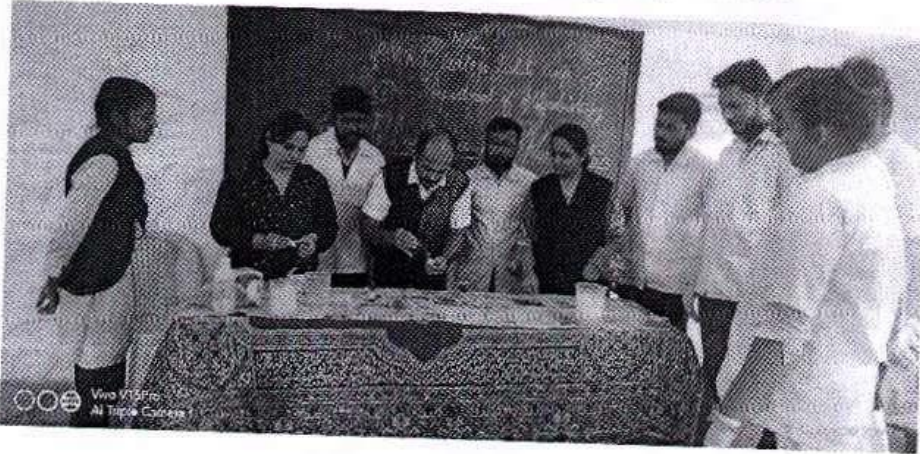

### Report On Tree Plantation 2019-2020



### Special Winter Camping Activities conducted at LAHVIT Adopted Village

Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj's Shrimati Vimlaben Khimji Tejookaya Arts, Science and Commerce College, Deolali Camp, Nasik and NSS organized a Special Winter Camping at Lahvit from 27<sup>th</sup> December 2019 to 2<sup>nd</sup> Jan 2020. As per the University Circular Lahvit Village has been adopted for 5 years. The main activities were to make villagers aware of water conservation, Health awareness, Dental Checkup, Cyber Security Awareness and Cleanliness. The following activities were successfully implemented.

#### 1) Cleanliness Awareness

The volunteers cleaned the ZP Primary School and Janata High school for 2 hours. Groups were formed and they visited the people and interacted about their needs and requirements. They also discussed with them about the harms of open defecation. They created the awareness of cleanliness, spread of diseases, importance of environment, use of electricity, water harvesting and importance of ground water. Volunteers cleaned the village roads, removed the dust heaps, garbage and cleared the stagnant drainage flows. They swept with brooms on the roads of the village. The Volunteers contacted the village people for the use of toilets and convinced them to avoid the habit of open defecation. The villagers were also made aware of the various schemes given by the government for constructing toilets. The volunteers achieved the common goal of community service during the camp.


#### 2) Shramadaan Programme:

The Volunteers organised the Shramadaan Programme. 150 Volunteers assembled at the Cemetery. The Volunteers cleaned the area of the Cemetery. They removed the heaps of dust and cleared the lane. The volunteers prepared the the Rough Road on the both sides of the Cemetery. The Grampanchayat provided the sandfly. The Volunteers collectively made the rough road about 1 Km on the both sides of the Cemetery during the Camp.

#### 3) Health Check Up Camp:

The free Health Check-up camp was organised in collaboration with Dr. Vasantrao Pawar Medical College and Research Centre. 15 Member team including the Physicians,

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Gyechologists, and other specialists doctors examined the villagers along with Blood sugar , ECG test. Approximately 300 villagers came for the health check-up camp. The doctors prescribed them the medicines and consulted them .

#### 4) Beti Bachav Rally :

Beti bachav Rally was organised and the street Play was performed in the village in main areas. The main objective of the programme was to create awareness among the people about the importance of girl child and to discourage them against the female foeticide. The street Play was performed and the achievement of the daughters of the country in the various fields were highlighted .

#### 5) Eye Check-up Camp:

A free Eye Check up camp was organised in collaboration with Tulsi Eye Hospital. The objective of the camp was to increase the awareness on eye disorders , their early detection and to detect refractive errors and eye ailments among the villagers and the primary and secondary school children. Around 120 free glasses were distributed to the villagers. Around 137 villagers were screened and 52 were detected with eye problems. 48 glasses were distributed to the villagers.


#### 6) Dental Check-up Camp:

The Camp was organised in collaboration with SMBT Dental College on dental awareness talk , educating the villagers , school children about common dental ailments , stressing on tooth decay , gum diseases and the measures to prevent them. The villagers were highlighted about the eating patterns and food choices . The surgeons interacted with the villagers , school children on oral diseases . The Surgeons recommended dental treatments .

#### 7) Lectures by Experts:

In order to create awareness among the villagers about role journalism, value education, various government schemes Constitution & Thoughts of Mahatma Gandhi, role and contributions of historical personage, the role of youth in nation building and the role and contribution of individual in environmental sustenance, experts from concerned fields were invited during the camp. The guidance given by the experts proved to be very valuable for the native people.




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**Outcome of the activities:**
