- Sunil Saundankar, the coordinator welcomed all members and also thanked newly nominated expert-members for sparing their valuable time for IQAC of the college. The coordinator read the minutes of the previous meeting held on 9th August 2022 and these minutes were unanimously confirmed by the members.
