This is one of the four Agricultural universities in the state with its jurisdiction spread over Western Maharashtra covering 10 districts, viz., Kolhapur, Sangli, Satara, Solapur, Pune, Ahmednagar, Nasik, Dhule, Jalgaon and Nandurabar. Background: Near Nashik biodiversity rich region Anjaneri hill siuated. This place is habitat of wild plants and animals. Anjaneri forest A total of **385 flowering plants** from **68 families** have been reported from Anjaneri protected area in the present study, of these **114 are endemics**. Out of these 114 species, 81 are endemic to India while 33 taxa are endemic to the Western Ghats.

Schedule: 23rd September 2023

Details of Activities Conducted: Our department organized extension activity "Chala Januya Vanana" with collaboration with forest department for our students to explore and study of Boidivery of plants and animals. In this activity 160 students 20 staff members were participated. Anjaneri rock outcrop shows great floral diversity due to varied microhabitats. The observations on phenology and adaptive traits were recorded. Our studts got knowledge about rare species of plant and animals fund on this place and create awareness about conservation. Dr. Pakanj Garg DCF taked on Jatayu Conservation and conservation Ceropegia rare plant found on Anjaneri hill only.



1. Introduction:-

a) About College

M.V.P samajs S.V.K.T College Dolali Camp is multidisciplinary college. It was in the

year 1984 considering the need of educational institute at Deolali Camp area, The College was established as there were students from around 45 remote villages who were deprived from education especially the girls. The College has been awarded with grade 'A' by NAAC during the second cycle of Assessment and Reaccreditation. It has taken many safety measures for girl students resulting into having more than 70% girl students. It runs Undergraduate as well as Post-graduate Programmes. Along with the Conventional Programmes the college has also been approved Skill based courses under B.Voc and Community College by UGC (NSQF). The College has an approved Study Centre for Distance Education, affiliated to Yashwantrao Chavan Open University. Now the college is planning to start few more PG Programmes as well as Research Centres in few subjects. Apart from the educational services the college has been known for providing many cocurricular and extra-curricular facilities to students. As a reward to the attempts made by the college in tree plantation by going beyond the campus, the college has been bestowed with Vanashree Puraskar by the Government of Maharashtra. Our Department of Botany made nursery of native forest plant species in which 25 thousand plantlets of 22 forest plant species were developed. The samplings were distributed among

students, staff, Grampanchyats, government offices, various organisations, schools, colleges, Ashram schools and rotary club free of cost as social responsibility for conservation of nature and natural resources.


b) About Anjaneri hill:-

High altitude plateaux are found throughout northern Western Ghats. These plateaux harbor a great diversity of monsoon flora and endemism but are highly neglected due to the seasonality and harsh climatic conditions. Anjaneri Hill is an important rock outcrop in northern Western Ghats. It is the type locality of *Ceropegia anjanerica*. As an attempt to make a floristic inventory of an important area, a preliminary study was undertaken. A total of **385 flowering plants** from **68 families** have been reported from Anjaneri protected area in the present study, of these **114 are endemics**. Out of these 114 species, 81 are endemic to India while 33 taxa are endemic to the Western Ghats. Anjaneri rock outcrop shows great floral diversity due to varied microhabitats. The observations on phenology and adaptive traits were recorded. The data on geology and geomorphology is presented in order to understand the geological nature of the rock outcrop. Intensive study on varied microhabitat is needed for the documentation of floral diversity existing on the Anjaneri Hill.

c) About Maharashtra state forest Department: -

Globally as well as nationally, Forest Conservation is increasingly being viewed as a powerful instrument in sequestering carbon and thereby offset adverse climate change.

Maharashtra Forest Department, being custodian of the State's rich and diverse bio-diversity, is committed to a conservation-centric management and protection strategy. Wild-life focused eco-tourism management hinges on sustainability. Production-be it timber / non-timber forest produce is managed with sustainability at its core. Joint Forestry Management to secure natural resources as well as livelihood security remains the major people-centric activity. Attempts are on to hone local artisans' skill in making value-added articles out of non-timber forest produce like bamboo and cane. Augmenting green cover on non-forest areas to achieve national targets of 33% of land area under green cover remains a forefront agenda. Intensive use of Information and Communication Technology supplemented by e-governance is under effective use to monitor ongoing forestry activities. Extensive use of digital platform to project a true picture of forest conservation forms the central theme.






Photo 03 :-Beyond campus green intiative through tree Plantation drive at Sukhdev Primary Marathi medium School Indiranagar , Nashik.







