The Revolutionary thought of **Mahatma Jyotirao Phule** " There is no other alternative but education for social change", created an awareness about education in the common masses of Maharashtra. The same thought was pursued by the great thinkers, reformers like His Highness **Rajarhee Shahu Maharaj**, His Highness **Shreemant Sayajirao Gaikwad Maharaj**, **Maharshee Vitthal Ramji Shinde**, **Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar**, **Dr. Karmveer Bhaurao Patil**, **Dr. Punjabrao Deshmukh** and others. All these personalities were great visionaries who firmly believed that unless we open the channels of education from pre-primary to higher level, the light of knowledge will not reach the doors of common masses in the villages. The followers of this tradition, **Karmveer Raosaheb Thorat**, **Karmveer Ganpatdada More**, **D.R.Bhosale** and others initiated the task of spreading education by establishing ' **Udoji Maratha Hostel** ' in 1914 .It was a significant beginning .It was in 1913 that,All India Maratha Education Conference was organized in Nashik, where His Highness **Shreemant Udojirao Pawar** of **Dhar Residency** donated Rs.10,000/- which strengthened the very foundation of the Institution. In order to stabilize the work of the Institution, His Highness started a grant of Rs. 2,000 /- per annum. **Rajarshee Shahu Maharaj** donated Rs.15000/-, **Shreemant Sayajirao Gaikwad Maharaj** donated Rs.12,000/-, His Highness **Shreemant Madhavrao Maharaj** of **Gwalior Residency** donated Rs.10,000/-.Then the **Industrialist Pandurang Javaji Chaudhari** of Mumbai donated Rs.3,000/- and others blessed the Institution in the form of donation so as to enable it to expand its educational work.

'Bahujan Hitaya Bahujan Sukhaya' for the Welfare and Happiness of the Common Masses is the motto of the Institution. To follow this motto and to help the masses, the social workers like **Shankarrao Kadam Kanadaladkar**, **Bhausaheb Hire**, **Kakasaheb Wagh**, **Annasaheb Murkute** came forward. The Institution gained name and fame in a short time due to well organization and disciplined planning. Since various donors and social workers belonging to various places generously helped the Institution, and a small plant of the Institution began to blossom. The year 1964 was celebrated as its Golden Jubilee year. The year 2014 is to be celebrated as its Centenary. The qualitative and quantitative sky rocketing development of the Institution is simply wonderful. The contribution and devotion of the ex-office bearers and in office bearers as well as the members of the Managing Council have made this possible.

In 2004-2005 Maratha Vidya Prasarak Samaj had organized 78th Akhil Bartiya Marathi Sahitya Sammelan and Vishwa Marathi Sahitya sammelan in February 22 in MVP Campus.

The Government of Maharashtra felicitated the Institution by giving State Award to honour its educational and social work. **Yashwantrao Chavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik** has praised the Institution by giving it the '**Punjabrao Deshmukh Award**' in 2006.

- 1) Students should remain present personally at the time of admission and for filling the examination form.

 - d) **Statement of Marks**
 - e) **Character Certificate**If a student fails to produce the above-mentioned documents, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.
- 9) All the admissions are provisional till they are finalized by the Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune.
- 10) The Original Leaving/Transference Certificate once submitted to the college will not be returned to the students.
- 11) All admissions will be made as per rules and regulations of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune and Government of Maharashtra.

Eligibility

As per University Circular No. (153) 1999, students are required to fulfill the eligibility criterion and rules of the said circular are applicable in this regard.

- a) While forwarding the admission form, students joining the first year (Arts, Science & Commerce Courses) after passing the Higher Secondary School certificate exam. (XII std.) of the Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education are required to fill in the form of eligibility.
- b) Students joining the university courses on the basis of passing any examination other than H.S.C. examination of Maharashtra State are required to fill in the form of eligibility.
- c) Students joining for any course on the basis of having passed qualifying examination from Savitribai Phule University of Pune will be required to fill in the form of eligibility.

Terms:

Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fees:

The Ministry of Human Resource Development and University Grants Commission have considered the issue and decided that the Institutions and Universities, in the public interest, shall maintain a waiting list of students/candidates. In the event of a students/ candidates withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat.

The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs.1000/- (One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student / candidate withdrawing from the program. If a student leave after joining the course and if the seat consequently falling vacant has been filled by another candidate by the last date of admission, the Institution must return the fee collected with proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable S.P. Pune University Ref No.CA/2826 dt.07/07/07.

Fee Refund / Cancellation of Fee:-

- 1) If a Student gets admission to any technical course or to a medical college after having taken admission in this college, his/her admission may be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per the table given below except as prescribed by the State Government/ University Competed Authority.
- 2) If a student takes admission to another Degree College after having taken admission in this college, his/her admission will be cancelled and his/her fees will not be refunded.
- 3) Once a student is given admission in this college, he/she will not be permitted to take admission to any other college run by the MVP Samaj.

Maintenance of Code of Conduct

Rules Regarding Discipline:

- 1) Students should abide themselves with the rules & regulations framed by the college authorities. Any misbehavior bringing disreputation to the college will not be tolerated.
- 2) Students should attend all their theory & practical classes. Students should not remain absent without permission of the college authorities. Minimum 75% of attendance is compulsory to fill in the examination form, and in case of default, college has the rights to withhold the examination form of the concerned student.
- 3). Students will have to attend all the tests & terminal examination conducted by the college.
- 4). Students are not allowed to set up any kind of organizations and associations in the college. A student should not bring along with him / her any outsider other than parents in the college premises.
 - a) As per University Circular No. 106/1998-99 smoking, consumption of Alcoholic drinks / Guthaka / Pan Masala is strictly prohibited in the College premises.
 - a) As per the circular of Maharashtra Govt. students are not allowed to use mobile phones in the college premises. Any students found Making use of mobile phones will be punished accordingly.
 - b) As per the M.V.P. Samaj decision use of uniform for the junior & senior college student, HSC Vocational students has been made compulsory from the academic year 2005-2006.
 - c) The students of F.Y/S.Y./ T.Y.B.Sc offering Chemistry and Microbiology as the subject will to use white aprons at the time of practical.
- 6). A student should carry his/her Identity card duly filled and signed by the college authorities to the college every day. The college identity card should be produced by the students immediately on the demand by the college authorities, teaching and non- teaching staff of the college. A student should complete the Identity card formalities within 10 days form the date of his/her admission. Any delay in this regard will be subject to late fee.
- 7). Students should note that causing damage to the college property is cognizable offence.
- 8). Roaming in the college premises is strictly not allowed. Students are expected to be in the Classrooms, Laboratories or Library reading rooms.
- 9). Students should not bring instruments like Radio, Camera, Tape recorder, ipod etc. in the college premises.
- 10). Students should park their two wheeler vehicles only in the parking area decided by the college authorities. Three or four wheeler vehicles are strictly prohibited for the students except differently able students.
- 11). Any sort of grievances can be brought to the notice of the Members of Discipline Committee or the Principal.
- 12). Dress code will be compulsory for the students of Senior College and Junior College. The details about the dress will be notified on the notice board at the time of admission.
- 13). Any outsider (who is not a student of this college), will be treated as a Tress Passer. 14). If a

student wants to lodge any complaint or make any written representation, it should be brought through proper channel.

- 15). If a students does not behave according to the above mentioned rules, as per the University statute 1974 us 86 (4) and c (8) circular No. 153/88, the principal of the college may inflict any of the following punishments.
- a) Cancellation of Admission.

 - c) Debarring form the Examination for a specific period not exceeding five years.
 - d) Cancellation of Exam. Result.
 - e) Rustication for specific period.
 - f) Imposition of fine not exceeding Rs. 300/-
 - g) Non Refund of Deposits.
- 16). Students in whose place a dummy student offers examination, he / she will be liable to go through legal action. His admission will stand cancelled automatically. Also he / she will not be given admission next year in the college.
- 17). It is compulsory for the students to remain present on 15th Aug., 19th Aug, 26th January and the Annual Ceremony in the college.
- 18). If any student is found in ragging activities serious action will be taken as per 'Maharashtra Ragging Pratibandhak Abhiniyan 1999' CIRCULAR NO. 170 Of 2009.
- 19). The college has constituted a Vishakha Committee/Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) in accordance with UGC guidelines to prevent and address sexual harassment, ensuring a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all students and staff."

-:Scholarships and Freeships:-

The notices of scholarships and free ships are put on the college notice boards from time to time. Students are required to read the instructions very carefully. If the students fail to fill the respective fee concession forms with the necessary documents, such students will be treated as paying students, and he / she will have to pay the necessary fees.

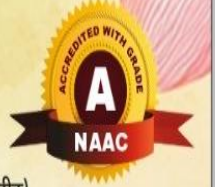
